## Your Weighmaster License May Be Expiring Soon.

Do you operate in a state where a Weighmaster license is required? If so, now is a good time to check to see when you need to renew that license. Your expiration date should be listed on your current license. **Colorado, Delaware, Louisiana, Maine and Virginia licenses will be expiring on December 31st, 2024.** Make sure you have submitted your renewal.

The following states DO require a Weighmaster license:

AL	AZ	CA	CO	CT
DE	GA	IN	LA	ME
MA	MS	NV	NH	NJ
NM	NY	NC	PA	SC
TN	TX	VT	VA	WA

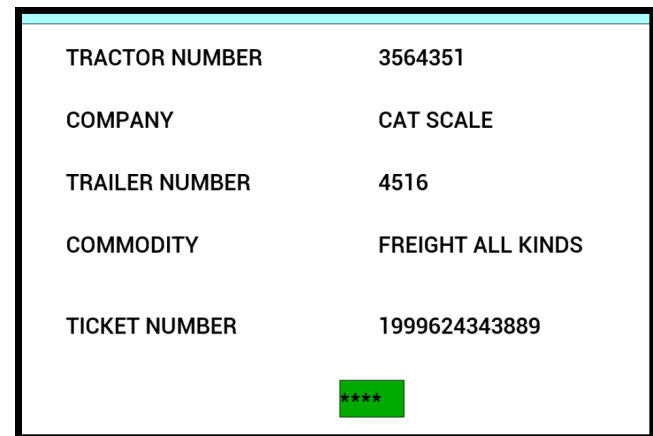
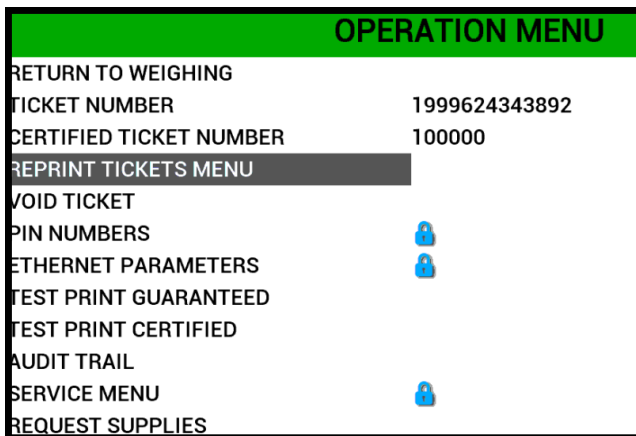

# How To: Reprint A Weigh My Truck Ticket

Weigh My Truck tickets, as well as regular weigh tickets, can be reprinted if needed from the CAT 2700 indicator menu. You can reprint a ticket for up to two hours after the original print. A ticket can only be reprinted one time.

1. Arrow down on the keyboard until “reprint tickets menu” is highlighted.
2. Select the weigh ticket you want to reprint, and hit enter.
3. Enter your four digit pin number.
4. A test ticket will print first with zero weights, then it will ask you to verify.
5. After you verify, the actual ticket will reprint.

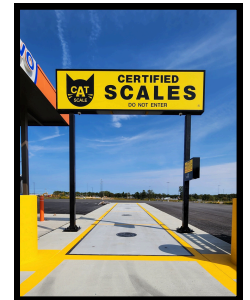
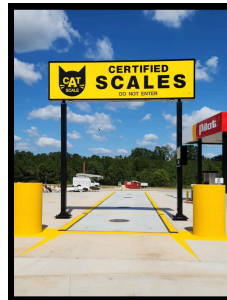
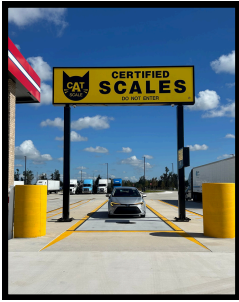
## Don't Forget: Laser Printer Ticket Tips

Most locations now use Brother or HP laser printers, or will be converted very soon. Here are some tips to make sure tickets are loaded properly and lessen the likelihood of a paper jam.

1. When loading tickets into the bottom tray, tickets must be loaded face down with the arrows pointing to the back of the tray (away from you).
2. Do not fill the tray with tickets past the red line. Overfilling may cause the printer to jam.
3. The CAT Scale Super Trucks Cards are on opposite ends of the tickets in an alternating pattern so they stack evenly. Please follow the arrows on the tickets for loading regardless of which end the cards are on.
4. Drivers always get two tickets. This means just handing the driver the full perforated sheet (or two separate sheets if it is a California Weighmaster Certificate).
5. If a ticket doesn't print, first check the paper tray to make sure it's not empty. If the paper tray is not empty, next check the LCD display for any errors. There are three places paper could be jammed in the printer, the location of the jam will be indicated on the LCD display.

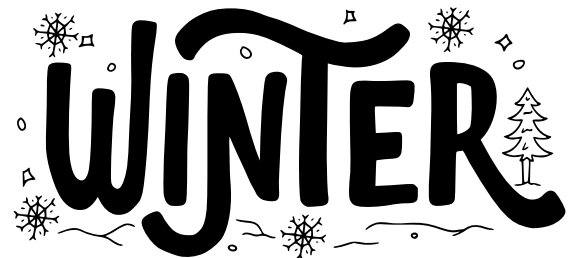


### Quick Tips

For many of you this is old news but, new employees and new locations are coming on board every week and will likely appreciate the help.

When a driver pulls on the scale and uses the Weigh My Truck™ application, you will:

- Hear an alert tone from the scale indicator. (This is a different tone from a regular weigh)
- Be prompted to accept the information shown on the screen.
- Verify the correct placement of the vehicle weighing by looking at your monitor.
- Enter your PIN number and press enter to authorize the transaction and display the weights.
- Press enter again once the weights are shown to finalize the transaction for the driver.



### Maintenance Tips

Here are some tips to keep your scale in operation during the unpredictable weather of the winter months for those in the snow belt.

- **Never use salt on your scale.** It will erode the concrete and damage your platform. Call CAT Scale for other options.
- **You may occasionally need to manually zero out your scale if it shows weight on the scale when there isn't a truck there.** (You can do this by pressing the "zero" button on your scale indicator. If this is a recurring problem, call the CAT Scale Help desk.)
- **Remove snow and any stray debris in a timely manner.** When plowing, be sure to back off the scale.
- **Check scale pits weekly** to catch water or ice problems before it's too late.
- **Call the CAT Scale Help Desk ASAP if you have a scale problem. 1-877-CAT-SCALE, ext. 6**

Remember, any time your scale is shut down it costs you money. Keeping your scale clear of debris is important and provides a great service to your customers.



# Winter Driving Safety Tips

## For Your Drive To & From Work

For those of us that have to deal with snow, driving in winter weather might be a walk in the park, or perhaps an uphill battle...both figuratively and perhaps literally if you slide off the road. It all depends on what Mother Nature throws our way. I encourage you to prepare for the worst and expect the unexpected. Preparation for driving in winter weather could save your life...figuratively, and literally!

**Establish a vehicle preparation kit.** The National Weather Service has developed the following list as items that should be in all vehicles when traveling in winter weather.

- First Aid Kit
- Jumper Cables
- Tire Chains or Snow-tires
- Flares or other signaling device
- A full tank of gas or fuel
- A bag of sand or cat litter
- Shovel, ice scraper, snow brush
- Tow Rope
- Blanket(s)
- Warm clothes, to include boots and mittens
- Flashlight
- Water and Snacks
- Cell Phone Charger

**Plan Your Route.** Check local and regional weather and traffic reports before heading out. If your roads are not in good shape, consider postponing non-essential travel until roads are cleared. Familiarize yourself with directions and maps before you go, and let others know your route and anticipated arrival time.

**Car Seat Recommendations.** In colder weather, parents typically dress their children in heavy winter coats. It's important to know that heavy coats can interfere with proper harness fit on a child in a car seat. Instead of bundling kids up in heavy winter coats, use a light-weight layer, buckle the child in, then use blankets over the harness to maintain warmth.

**Your tires are your connection to the road.** As temperatures drop, so does tire inflation pressure. Check the owner's manual or the label located on the driver's side door frame for appropriate tire pressures. Check pressure when the tires are cold, as that gives you a more accurate reading. Check your tires regularly for damage or conditions that may need attention, such as cuts, punctures, bulges, scrapes or cracks to the sidewalls or treads. The tread should be at least 2/32 of an inch or greater on all tires. Don't forget to check your spare tire!

**Finally, Stay Put!** If you do go off the road or get stuck in any way in the winter weather, stay with your vehicle. Emergency crews are more likely to find you if you stay with your vehicle. You will also have a source of heat (provided you followed the recommendations above and kept a full tank of fuel). Check the exhaust pipe of your vehicle to ensure that it is not blocked while the engine is running. Use your cell phone to notify someone of your location and situation. Turn on flashing lights in your vehicle to alert passers by of your presence.
